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Nicole Kaufman, whose son Daniel died of brain cancer in 2000, is determined to change the way children and young adults with brain tumours are diagnosed and treated Daniel Kaufman, then aged eight, was a happy, energetic and sociable child. By the age of two, he was diagnosed with a brain tumour and the prognosis was grave. Nicole Kaufman had been told her son would not live beyond four years. He died four months before his fourth birthday. In the weeks before his death, he seemed more child than boy.
