New York Gov. Andrew Cuomo will have a \$10,000 donation to his reelection campaign returned after the state comptroller found it is not legal. The return of the \$10,000 donation made by a fund linked to the liberal billionaire George Soros comes after Cuomo's office acknowledged in June 2017 that it was illegal for the governor to solicit such a donation. "I think it is important to know who contributes to a campaign and what their interest is in the campaign," Cuomo said in May, after the donation was returned. On the day of the return, Cuomo's office released a statement saying "the Campaign for Governor is following the Office of the New York State Comptroller's (NYS Comptroller) advice on campaign-related contributions, including the Statewide Campaign Fund (SWCF)." "Specifically, they have advised that contributions from the SWCF are not legal for the Governor's General Election Campaign. The campaign has followed the advice of the NYS Comptroller and will be returning any contributions from the SWCF to the donor," the statement continued. The NYS Comptroller had also asked about the legality of the fund after it made a \$10,000 contribution to the governor's campaign. In an interview with Fox News on Sunday, Cuomo said it was "absurd"
