Square Enix didn't do it justice by releasing the first two games on the GameCube and PlayStation 2, so fans have long awaited a proper release on the PlayStation 3. As a result, many are disappointed to learn that the new version of the franchise won't be coming to North America, where it wasn't even released in the

West back in 2003. As reported by GameSpot, Tales of Symphonia will be available in North America as part of Sony's PlayLink program, where it will cost \$9.99. That's an expense that Nintendo's Wii U Virtual Console would likely take up to 50 times over, though it's not all bad news for fans of the game. The latest Tales of Symphonia: Dawn of the New World, which was released in Japan in 2010, will not be available in North America. But it looks like the game will be released in Japan sometime in 2014, according to a recent entry on Square

Enix's website. In addition to PlayStation 3 versions of the first two Tales of Symphonia games, Square Enix has also said that the 2006 title, Tales of Symphonia: A New Dawn, will be released for the PlayStation Portable, Xbox 360, Wii U and PlayStation Vita. Tales of Symphonia: A New Dawn was originally released in Japan in 2006 as Tales of Legendia, but fans were disappointed that it was only released in the country. Last June, Square Enix announced that it would release a new Tales of Symphonia game, titled Tales

of Symphonia: Dawn of the New World. The company said at the time that the game would be a remake of the original 2006 title, rather than a sequel. A new RPG coming to the PlayStation Vita in Japan in 2014 sounds like
